

Thank you for your interest in Geisinger Janet Weis Children's Hospital's Child Life practicum experience.

The Geisinger Janet Weis Children's Hospital Child Life practicum experience is a 10-week observation that involves two shifts per week (6 hour days). During the practicum, you will be observing child life specialists in two different clinical areas. Additionally, there will be weekly readings and assignments.

Pre-requisites for the practicum experience:

• Students must be at a minimum junior level standing in their baccalaureate program (sophomore standing may be approved contingent upon completion of coursework requirement)

- Students must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Students must have completed at least five college level courses focused on child life, child development, developmental psychology or family systems
- Students must have completed volunteer hours with children in a "well" setting (i.e. summer camps, church groups, babysitting, etc.)
- Preference will be given to students who also have a minimum of 25 hours of volunteer experience in a hospital/healthcare setting

• Due to Department of Labor regulations, students must be affiliated with a college or university throughout their practicum experience
