

Positive Practices Committee (PPC)

Positive Practices is comprised of State, regional, and county workgroups whose focus is to explore and expand local capacity, training, resources, cross system collaboration, and how to meet the needs of the local community, particularly for those individuals who are considered most challenging and those with a dual diagnosis (MH/MR).

The committee's mission is "To improve people's lives by increasing local capacity to provide supports to individuals with mental health and behavioral challenges by promoting the guiding principles of Positive Approaches, Everyday Lives and the Recovery Movement through a Department of Public Welfare system collaboration."

PPC meetings will be held on the fourth Tuesday of every other month (February, April, August, October and December) and hosted at various locations. These PPC meetings are open to providers of behavioral health and intellectual disability services. Registration is not required.

Our next meeting will be October 27, 2009 at The American Legion Building in Centre Hall. The physical address is 2928 Penns Valley Pike, Centre Hall, 16828. The area is known as Old Fort and is located almost at the intersection of Routes 45 and 144. For those coming from Harrisburg, it is an easy trip using Route 322.
