KEY

Block: Due to the 6+2 schedule, there are 26 two-week blocks over the course of the year; "a" above indicates the first 2 weeks of the block, "b" indicates second 2 weeks of the block

Rotations: **AMB** = Ambulatory rotation including continuity clinic and various other outpatient clinic experiences (ex. CHF clinic, COPD clinic, Nephro clinic, GI clinic, Addiction Medicine, etc.)

Cards = Inpatient cardiology rotation inclusive of cardiac intensive care unit patients

ED = Emergency Medicine rotation

Geri = Geriatrics rotation

GIM = Inpatient Internal Medicine ward rotation

ICU = Critical Care Medicine rotation in the medical intensive care unit

IEE = Individualized Educational Experiences. All residents will have 6 months of IEE throughout their training, tailored toward their post-residency career goals.

Neuro = Neurology rotation with exposure to both vascular and general neurology services

NF = Night Float Internal Medicine rotation

TTP = Transition to Practice rotation (inpatient ward rotation designed to promote autonomy)

Triage = Triage rotation (residents assess patients for admission and evaluate level of acuity)

Vaca = 2 week vacation block. All interns receive a 2 week vacation block plus additional vacation days to take throughout the year. PGY2 and PGY3 residents may elect to take a 2 week vacation block per year if they choose.
