Better safe than sorry

Getting a shingles vaccine is highly recommended for people over 50. This vaccine helps to reduce the risk of getting shingles as well as reducing its painful symptoms, if they occur.

Shingles vaccinations are covered for Geisinger Gold members who have our Part D coverage. This means the prescription cost and the cost for its administration are covered if you buy and receive the vaccination at a Gold Network pharmacy that offers vaccination services.

To purchase the vaccine at a network pharmacy and take it to your doctors for administration, you will need a prescription from your doctor to purchase the vaccine. You may need to pay out-of-pocket costs at your doctor's office like provider fees or co-pays.

Are you a Geisinger Gold Secure Rx (HMO SNP) member? If so, there's a small change coming your way. No worries, though. We're not going anywhere, and neither are you!

Beginning Jan. 1, 2020, the Pennsylvania Department of Human Services (DHS) will no longer administer your Medical Assistance benefits. You'll receive information this summer directing you to choose a new company to administer your Medical Assistance benefits. Once you make that decision, you'll be set to continue as usual.

More importantly, this has no effect on your Medicare Advantage benefits. We will continue to provide you the Geisinger Gold benefits you know and love, as well as work with your new Medical Assistance administrator to coordinate coverage as needed.

A Matter of Balance

As we age, a common concern is around falling or restricting your activities due to the fear of falling. "A Matter of Balance" is designed to help you manage falls and increase activity levels.

Participants meet once a week for two hours with trained leaders for eight weeks
