

Operations Bulletin – May 1, 2023

Correction to this bulletin issued Jun. 1, 2023 – Taxonomy code should be used in box 24Ja when billing GHP Family. The bulletin previously stated that EIN should be used in box 24Ja.

FQHC and RHC providers must bill GHP Family under business name, organizational NPI and taxonomy starting July 1, 2023

In accordance with the Pennsylvania Department of Human Services (DHS), GHP Family, Geisinger's Managed Medical Assistance (Medicaid) plan, will only accept claims from Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHCs) and Rural Health Clinics (RHCs) that are billed using group identification and information, effective July 1, 2023. Beginning July 1, 2023, GHP Family will no longer accept claims submitted by FQHCs and RHCs that are billed under individual providers. All care and services provided by an FQHC or RHC should be billed under the group name, organizational (type 2) NPI and taxonomy code.

Tips for your GHP Family claims starting July 1, 2023

- When using the CMS1500 claim form, make sure your group information is used in box 24J. Enter your organizational (type 2) NPI number in box 24Jb and your taxonomy code in box 24Ja.
- For electronic claims (EDI), make sure your group information is used in Loop 2310B.
- Bill the applicable location code (50 or 72) and the appropriate CPT/HCPCs codes (T1015) on the first line of the claim. Don't forget any applicable modifiers.
- You can continue to bill \$0.00 for all other services than the visit code on their claims submitted to GHP Family.
