To Whom it may concern:

The Geisinger Commonwealth School of Medicine bloodborne pathogen exposure policy states that all costs for testing, immunization, prophylactic medication and follow up care as a result of exposure will be covered by the School for the first month, and the student's health insurance will be billed thereafter.

Students must report to Employee Health if the exposure occurs during regular business hours. If the exposure occurs after regular business hours a student must go to the local emergency department for evaluation. This letter is to ensure that providers know about our policy and that the school is responsible for payment for the first month of care
