Requirements: University degree and one prior CPE unit is required (Master of Arts, Master of Divinity or Master of Theology is preferred)

Applicants are screened for nicotine as part of the pre-education physical process through urine drug screenings. We will rescind offers to the CPE Program to any students who test positive for nicotine.
