

## Geisinger Clinical Pastoral Education Residency Program

Geisinger Medical Center in Danville Pa., includes a Level I adult trauma center, a pediatric trauma center, the Hospital for Advanced Medicine and extensive and intensive inpatient and outpatient services.

### Enrollment is open for the 2020 - 2021 group

Term: Aug. 17, 2020 - Aug. 13, 2021

**Tuition:** Upon your acceptance into the residency, you will pay a nonrefundable \$100 deposit, which is required to hold your spot in the program

**Credit:** Four units of Level I and/or Level II CPE upon completion of the residency program.

This program includes a competitive stipend of \$36,067, as well as vacation time, benefits, meal coverage for overnight shifts and required texts.

**Requirements:** University degree and one prior CPE unit is required (Master of Arts, Master of Divinity or Master of Theology is preferred)

### Smoking policy

Geisinger does not accept applicants who use tobacco products, including cigarettes, cigars and chewing or smokeless tobacco. Applicants are screened for nicotine as part of the pre-education physical process through urine drug screenings. We will rescind offers to the CPE Program to any students who test positive for nicotine.
