Geisinger Clinical Pastoral Education Residency Program

Geisinger Medical Center in Danville, PA includes a Level I adult trauma center, a pediatric trauma center, the Hospital for Advanced Medicine, and extensive and intensive inpatient and outpatient services.

Enrollment is open for the 2022-2023 residency year.

Term: August 15, 2022 – August 11, 2023

Tuition: Upon your acceptance into the residency, you are required to pay a non-refundable \$100 deposit to hold your spot in the program.

Credit: Four (4) units of Level I and/or Level II CPE upon completion of the residency program. This program includes a competitive stipend of \$38,213, as well as vacation/sick time, competitively priced health benefit package, a meal allowance for overnight shifts, and all required texts.

Educational Requirements: University degree and one (1) prior CPE unit is required.

(Master of Arts, Master of Divinity or Master of Theology is preferred.)

Smoking policy: Geisinger does not accept applicants who use tobacco products, including cigarettes, cigars, and chewing or smokeless tobacco. Applicants are screened for nicotine as part of the preeducation physical process through drug screenings. We will rescind offers to the CPE program to any students who test positive for nicotine.

Vaccination policy: CPE program applicants are required to receive a Tuberculin test, and both the influenza vaccination and the COVID-19 vaccination or provide acceptable proof of appropriate contraindication requiring accommodations.
