Research shows there are five health conditions in individuals with IDD that often go unrecognized and are linked to serious illness and preventable deaths in community-based settings. They are referred to as The Fatal Five: Aspiration, Constipation, Dehydration, Seizures and Sepsis

As more individuals with IDD transition into community settings, support staff play a vital role in the lives of the people they care for. Knowing how to prevent, recognize and seek treatment for select medical situations will not only improve the quality of their care, but will also save lives.
