RESEARCH INTERESTS

My career goal is to better understand and improve how healthcare is delivered and experienced. To accomplish this goal, I will draw upon multiple theoretical perspectives and utilize a variety of methodologic approaches. Currently, I examine ways to improve the delivery of care focusing on the optimization of medication use. I am especially interested in generating, evaluating, disseminating, and implementing evidence around and approaches to de-prescribing. My Ph.D thesis focused on the relationship between adolescents with asthma and the medication they use to manage their asthma and how to facilitate a conversation around asthma medication use between clinicians and adolescents, specifically focusing on step-down. My previous work has focused on evidence based medicine and how it is implemented in practice, specifically through the use of shared decision making and minimally disruptive medicine. These areas complement each other as together they make up a paradigm of healthcare where the care a person receives is not only informed by the best available evidence, but also by their values and context where what is best for the patient and their family is prioritized. To that end, I have been involved in several systematic reviews summarizing the best available evidence, but I have also critiqued the way evidence is used. Specifically, I have critiqued how evidence is interpreted and translated for use into practice. In collaboration with experts from around the world I have evaluated evidence and critiqued guidelines from a variety of sources including the American Association of Clinical Endocrinologists and the World Health Organization. These efforts will hopefully encourage thoughtful discussion of the limitations of evidence and how that evidence can be used to inform practice.
