EKG machine CH 2 & 3 Giraffe omnibed Neonatal Intensive Care Unit Provides complete care station for newborn infants

Vital signs monitors CH 2 & 3/Pediatric Dentistry Allows for vital signs monitoring for conscious sedations

Nitrous oxide system **Emergency Department** Offers safe sedative for procedures in the emergency room

Mechanical infantometer Foss Clinics 3 & 6 Obtains accurate length measurements of infants under 2

Stretcher scale Foss Clinics 3 & 6 Allows accurate weighing of patients confined to a wheelchair
