### Equipment for Geisinger Janet Weis Children's Hospital, Danville

#### Breast pumps

GMC Childbirth Center

*Expands on the ability for mothers to provide breast milk for their newborns*

#### Bed warmer

GMC Childbirth Center

*Provides means for initial resuscitation of preterm and full-term newborns after delivery*

#### Mini telemetry system

*Monitors and ensures well-being of the baby while mother is active and mobile throughout labor*

#### Freestanding warmer

*Offers for rewarming of hypothermic newborns after initial resuscitation*

*Provides an overnight stay for family members of patients when other accommodations are not available*

**Family Advisory Board** Patient & Family Centered Care  
*Assists the volunteer group focused on serving patients' and families' needs during hospital stays*

**Guest tray vouchers** Geisinger Janet Weis Children's Hospital & Geisinger Wyoming Valley  
*Helps relieve the financial burden of lengthy hospital stays by providing a meal to family members of the patient*

**Discharge to home vouchers** Patient & Family Centered Care  
*Provides means for families brought by EMS services to the children's hospital to return home if no ride is available*

**Ketogenic diet program** Neurology/Nutrition  
*Works to educate families about dietary way to control seizures for children who can't be treated with medication*

**Safe sleep swaddles** Geisinger Wyoming Valley NICU and nursery  
*Take-home swaddles for patients discharged from the NICU and nursery to promote safe sleep at home*

**Beanie Babies** Pediatric Plastic Surgery  
*Provides each patient with a stuffed animal for comfort and distraction during IV start and sedation induction*

**Outpatient transportation** Pediatric specialties  
*Provides transportation to current patients from specialty appointments for those in areas without other transportation*
