### Transport incubator

GMC Life Flight

Provides stabilization of newborn with ventilator support and controlled environment during transport to the NICU

## Cellie Cancer Coping kits

**GMC** pediatrics

Gives patients and their caregivers tools to aid in understanding and managing their diagnosis

#### Billirubin meter

Labor and Delivery

Offers noninvasive way to measure newborns for jaundice in the days after delivery

Infant warmer for resuscitation Labor & Delivery

Offers specialized warming area for child that needs immediate resuscitation after birth

## **Privacy screen**

Labor & Delivery

Provides privacy for mother to nurse her newborn while allowing family members to stay in the patient's room

### **Newborn incubators**

Provides a safe temperature and humidity controlled environment for newborn premature babies

Portable monitors Labor & Delivery and NICU Battery-operated equipment allows for a portable, reliable way to track patient vitals during beginning of hospital stays

Operating microscope Pediatric Sedation and PICU Allows for magnification and ample LED lighting for surgeons performing procedures on small children
