When everyday activities start taking more time or effort — like walking on uneven ground or standing up quickly — you're at higher risk of injury. And because even a minor fall can lead to serious setbacks, prepare yourself with practical ways to stay safe.

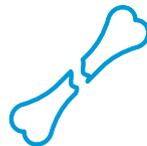


Connecting you to healthy food

Access to healthy food is essential to good health. That's why Geisinger Health Plan offers programs to help make nutritious food more affordable and accessible through our Food is Health approach, including:

- Mobile food pantries delivering fresh options to rural areas
- SNAP application support
- Fresh Food Farmacy programs for members with diabetes

Keep your bones strong. Calcium and vitamin D support bone health and reduce the risk of fractures. If your doctor suspects a deficiency, they can check vitamin D levels with a simple blood test.



Improve strength and balance. Muscle loss affects balance over time. Gentle exercises such as ankle rolls, heel-to-toe walking, sit-to-stand movements and stretching will help you maintain stability. Use a chair for support, if needed.



Get regular eye exams. Vision changes are common with age — and can increase fall risk. Have an annual eye exam and visit the doctor promptly if you notice sudden changes.



Stand up slowly. Sudden changes in position can cause lightheadedness. Take a moment to sit before standing, especially when getting out of bed.

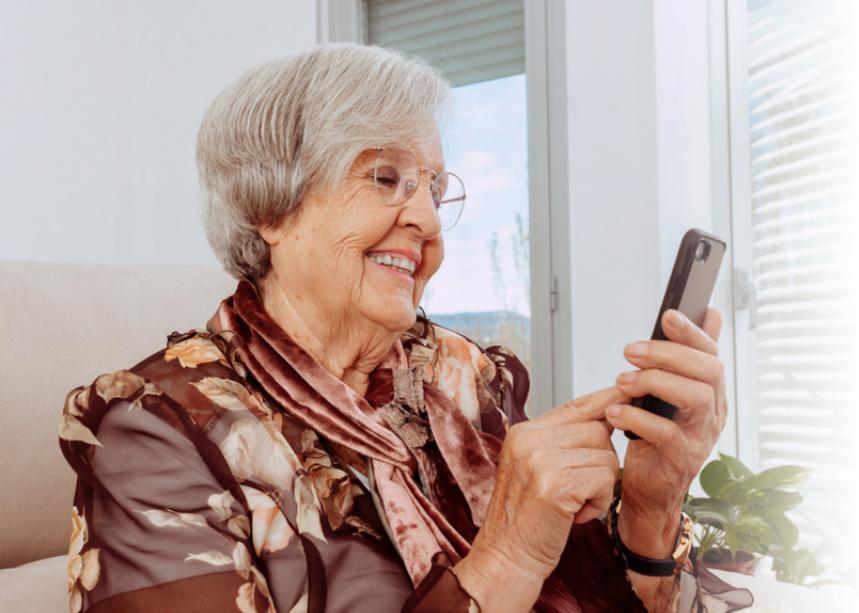


Know your medications. Some medications cause dizziness or drowsiness. Ask about side effects when starting a new prescription.



Create a safer home. Maintain good lighting, cool indoor temperatures and secure handrails. Remove trip hazards like loose rugs or cords, too, to reduce your fall risk.

By understanding how your body changes with age and taking simple steps to reduce fall risks, you can stay independent and keep doing the things you love with confidence.
