## Good health is rewarding

If your child is enrolled in CHIP brought to you by Geisinger Health Plan Kids, you could earn a variety of rewards just for keeping your child up to date on routine vaccines, well visits, dental visits and health screenings.

Once your child completes any of these activities on or after Jan. 1, 2026, you'll earn a gift card.



**Lead screening:** Earn a \$10 gift card if your child gets 1 capillary or venous blood test for lead poisoning by age 2.



**Annual dental visit:** Just 1 preventive dentist visit during the calendar year will earn you a \$25 gift card.



### Well visits:

- If your child goes to 6 well visit appointments before age 15 months, you'll earn a \$15 gift card then another \$15 gift card if they go to 2 more visits between 15 and 30 months.
- Any enrollee age 3 to 17 who completes 1 well visit appointment each year earns a \$30 gift card.



### Immunizations:

- When your child receives both the meningococcal vaccine (between ages 11 and 13) and the Tdap vaccines (between ages 10 and 13), earn a \$25 gift card.
- When your child age 9 to 13 receives both HPV vaccine doses, earn a \$30 gift card.

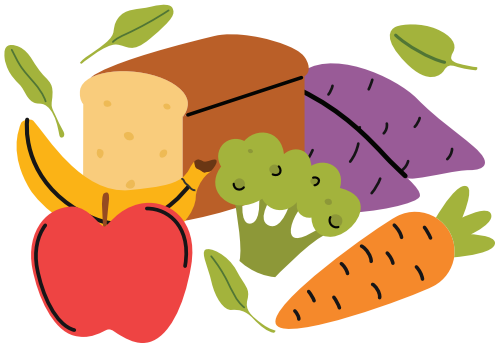
# Healthy snacks for kids at school



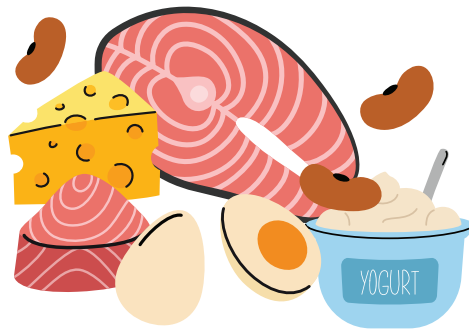
As the school year gets closer, families are getting ready with supplies and new routines. Besides backpacks and notebooks, snacks are another tool — one that can help kids stay focused and energized during the school day.

Many snacks sold at the store are convenient, but they're often highly processed and full of sugar or unhealthy fat. Though they taste good, they don't have the nutrients children's bodies and brains need to learn. With a little planning, families can choose snacks that are healthier and just as easy to pack.

## The best school snacks include 3 main parts:



**Fiber** helps kids feel full longer and keeps energy steady. It comes from fruits, vegetables and whole grains.



**Protein** builds strong muscles and bones and gives lasting energy. It comes from foods like cheese, yogurt, beans, nuts and lean meats.



**Healthy fats** support brain health. They're found in nuts, seeds and foods like avocado.

High-sugar snacks can cause kids to feel tired soon after eating, so it's harder to pay attention in class. Choosing better snacks can help kids feel calm, alert and ready to learn.

Smart snack ideas include string cheese with whole-grain crackers, hummus with vegetables, yogurt with fresh fruit, brown rice cakes, whole-wheat pita with bean dip, popcorn, trail mix, celery with nut butter and raisins, edamame and baked sweet potato chips.

Plus, healthy snacks don't have to be homemade. When you're shopping, look for snacks with less sugar, salt and unhealthy fats. Foods that are less processed are usually better choices.

Finally, no matter which snack you choose, remind your child that portion size matters. Eating the right amount helps kids listen to their bodies and keeps them healthy and strong.



# Don't lose your child's benefits!

To keep all your child's benefits from GHP Kids, they have to stay eligible for CHIP. Each year, you'll get a renewal packet in the mail from the Department of Human Services (DHS) when it's time to renew their CHIP coverage (at least 45 days before it's due).

Complete your renewal online on the COMPASS website, [dhs.pa.gov/COMPASS](https://dhs.pa.gov/COMPASS). You can also renew by completing and returning the forms by mail or in

person at your local County Assistance Office, or you can renew by phone at [866-550-4355](tel:866-550-4355).

Be sure to submit your renewal, even if nothing has changed. Make updates to your address and phone number by contacting your local County Assistance Office or by calling our GHP Kids Customer Care team at [866-621-5235](tel:866-621-5235) (TTY: 711). Also be sure to update your mailing address with the United States Postal Service (USPS) at [moversguide.usps.com](https://moversguide.usps.com).

DHS will determine if your child is still eligible. If they are, their coverage under GHP Kids will continue uninterrupted.
