Medical assistance

Student Health Services can provide health services and referrals. Students can go to any of the three area hospitals for medical services. A police report is **not** required to receive medical assistance. A Sexual Assault Exam is available at Geisinger Community Medical Center. The exam includes preventive treatment for sexually transmitted infections. pregnancy and evidence collection. A Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner (SANE) or forensic examiner who has received specialized training performs the exams.
