Generally, you must pay all of the costs from <u>providers</u> up to the <u>deductible</u> amount before this <u>plan</u> begins to pay. Are there services covered before you meet your <u>deductible</u> ?	Yes. <u>Preventive care</u> and primary care services are covered before you meet your <u>deductible</u> .
